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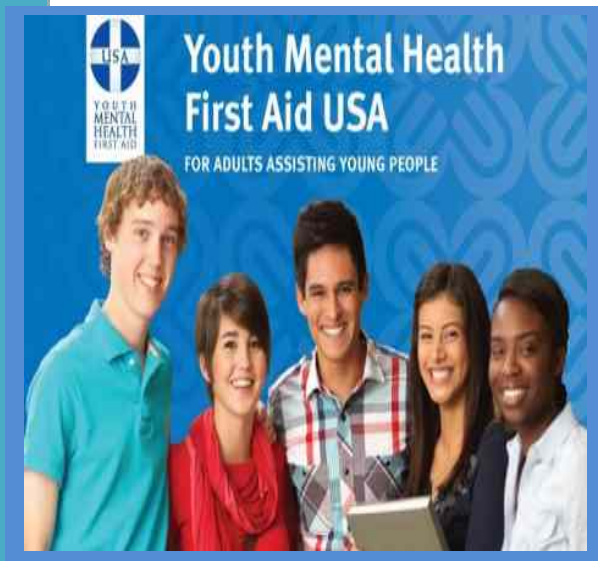

Youth Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) is an educational program which introduces participants to the unique risk factors and warning signs of mental health problems in adolescents, builds understanding of the importance of early intervention, and most importantly – teaches individuals how to help a youth in crisis or experiencing a mental health or substance use challenge.

Youth Mental Health First Aid is primarily designed for adults – healthcare and human services workers, family members, caregivers, school personnel – who work with young people ages 12-18, and is also appropriate as a peer support program for older adolescents. The curriculum spans mental health challenges for youth, review of normal adolescent development, and intensive guidance through the ALGEE action plan for both crisis and non-crisis situations.
